
Payments for upcoming events will continue as usual until we are able to advise you that the club account is open.

I still have some rooms available for this and I repeat all the details from last month's newsletter.

Room Details

Cottage Standard Room for 2 people sharing with breakfast & evening meal £660 in total. Cottage Standard Room for single occupancy with breakfast & evening meal £435 in total.

The Cottage rooms are in a separate building which is a converted barn and all the rooms are very modern with en-suite bathrooms with either free standing shower or bath with shower overhead.

They are all accessible via one flight of stairs, so no lift.

There are quite a few upgrade options as follows:-

Cottage Suite

Ground Floor Cottage room in grounds of hotel, has lounge area and small kitchen. £30 per room per night

Manor Classic Room

In main hotel building on first floor. £15 per room per night

Manor Deluxe Room

In main hotel building on first floor, larger room. £30 per room per night

Manor Easy Access

On Ground floor of the main hotel, spacious room with walk-in shower £30 per room per night

Manor Deluxe Plus

In the main hotel building on first floor, larger room. £45 per room per night

Manor Deluxe 4 Poster In main hotel on first floor

£45 per room per night

There is a non-refundable deposit of £50 per person to be paid in advance and I need to collect these asap to secure your room. However, if a room is cancelled prior to one month before our arrival, provided the room can be re-sold, your deposit will be refunded.
